General Terms and Conditions

1. Services provided by EUROFORUM

The services to be provided by EUROFORUM, a Business Division of EUROFORUM Deutschland SE (hereafter referred to as "EUROFORUM"), are regulated in the booking form.

2. Services to be performed by the partner

- a) In return for the services to be performed by EUROFORUM named in the booking form, the partner is to provide the relevant remuneration that is also regulated in the booking form, which will be invoiced by EUROFORUM when the booking confirmation has been received.
- b) Payment is to be made after the invoice has been issued.
- c) In the case of late payment by the partner, EUROFORUM has the right to charge default interest in the amount of 5% above the basic rate of interest per year (Article 247, Paragraph 1, German Civil Code). EUROFORUM reserves the right to claim any further default damages in excess of this amount. Similarly, the partner is entitled to prove that damage has either not arisen at all or is significantly less than that asserted by EUROFORUM.

3. Guarantee and liability

- a) The partner guarantees that they hold the required usage rights for the names, logos, signs and photographs, etc. to be used and that their use by EUROFORUM is authorised without restrictions under corporate and trademark law, as well as under competition law.
- b) The partner is liable for any claims for damages from third parties, irrespective of their legal basis, that are connected to a breach of the guarantee according to section 3. a), as well as for all associated expenses (including legal defence) incurred by EUROFORUM.
- c) The customer is obligated to release EUROFORUM from all claims for damages from third parties in connection with the operation of an exhibition stand.

4. Start of the contract

The contract starts when the booking form is signed by the partner.

5. Right of withdrawal from the contract by EUROFORUM

EUROFORUM retains the right to withdraw from the contract in the following cases:

- a) If the event is cancelled
- b) If any constraints arise as a result of known obligations to third-party cooperation partners, which have not yet been finalised at this point in time, such as speakers, hotels, etc. that make the fulfilment of this contract impossible
- c) If the partner has not made the required documentation available by the agreed deadline
- d) Insofar as the partner has entered into bankruptcy or composition proceedings

In all of the cases named above, the partner will be reimbursed either in part or in full for already delivered services/payments within the framework of statutory regulations. Any further claims for damages or other claims made by the partner above and beyond this are excluded.

6. Right of withdrawal from the contract by the partner

- a) Cancellations by the partner must always be made in writing.
- b) In the case of a cancellation up to 2 weeks before the printing deadline for the conference brochure, 50% of the full invoice amount will be charged.
- c) If a cancellation is received later than 2 weeks before the print deadline for the conference brochure then the full invoice amount is due.
- d) The date when the written cancellation is received is the valid date used to determine the cancellation charges.

7. Applicable laws, place of jurisdiction and place of performance

German law applies to the exclusion of the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods. Insofar as it is legally permissible, the place of performance and the jurisdiction is agreed to be Düsseldorf.
